CONCOURS

The vehicle and its components must be in a condition of original specification, free from blemishes, faults and wear.

This condition will only apply to vehicles previously entered or being proposed for entry in concours competition and evidence of entry may be required.

A1+

The vehicle must exceed A1 - TOP CLASS and with little effort to be considered to be Concours.

A1 TOP CLASS

The vehicle must be in excellent condition with bodywork/chassis free from rust. The vehicle's components should be free from any but trivial faults and should work efficiently.

A2 AVERAGE

The Vehicle should be in good working order, capable of regular use and satisfying an MOT Test requirement. The bodywork/chassis must be free of extensive rust and/or damage.

A3 SERVICEABLE

The vehicle must be in a roadworthy condition and be capable of satisfying an MOT Test requirement.

A considerable amount of work may be required to make the vehicle condition A2 or better.

Details of work completed since purchase

Include details of any non-authentic fittings, modifications from the manufacturer's original specification, repairs, special features or comments. Any significant history of the car should be shown.

Give details of all security and/or fire suppression devices fitted to vehicle(s) or garage - eg: burglar alarms / immobilisers / locks / fire alarms / fire extinguishers / padlocks, etc.
